Student poster and oral presentations at the 2013 PFT will be judge separately. Student ORAL presentations will be judged based on two main categories, DELIVERY and CONTENT. In each category judges are expected to assign points, in increments of 0.5, for each item as listed below.

1	Effective delivery (audible, faces audience, makes eye contact, etc.)	(1)
2	Clear enunciation and pronunciation; no stuttering i.e., 'um', 'er', 'you know', mispronunciation, etc.	(1)
3	Slides legible from back of room, well labeled, not overcrowded	(1)
4	Effective use of time: reasonable amount of time for intro, methods, results and discussion, (e.g. not most of time on background and little new info)(1	
5	Stays within allotted time, with time available for questions	(1)

1	Background: adequate amount of background	(2)
2	Methods and Analyses: provides clear and concise description	(2)
3	Results: clear presentation of MOST relevant results	(2)
4	Conclusions: presents logical conclusion from the results	(2)
5	Implications: puts study results into larger context – "so what?"	(1
6	Novelty: has the study been conducted by others? Has the study been at other conferences w/ little novelty added to the current presentation	•
